SUBJECT: City Council approval to submit an application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) / St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD) Alternative Water Supply Grant Program for the infrastructure necessary to interconnect reclaimed water systems with the Clay County Utility Authority (CCUA). *Scott Schultz*

BACKGROUND

Before and during the process of designing / permitting the Magnolia Point Reclaimed Water System staff have been having discussions as to supplying reclaimed water to CCUA. Staff and Mittauer have completed some initial modeling of the potential interconnection points and the ability for the city's reclaimed water system to support certain communities that are serviced by CCUA.

While an exact cost has not yet been determined, the timeline for application is drawing close. Full details will be provided once completed. As with all grant / funding programs, no firm committal to the program is required without an actual contract.
