PLANNING

3 new business licenses were issued, and one business transferred ownership. New businesses are:

- Revenues for Planning related fees for May were \$8,2438.35.


CODE ENFORCEMENT

In May, there were twenty one new enforcement complaints filed. Voluntary compliance was achieved for nine of the cases resulting in case closure. For Fiscal Year 2023-2024, Code Enforcement has collected \$14,180.56 in Code Enforcement fines.

Compliance for April courtesy notice of violation/notice of violations:

- 9 of 21 (42%) courtesy notices of violation/notice of violation were complied with.
- 1 of 13 (7%) notices of violation were voluntary complied with.
- 25 notices of violation from previous months compliance were achieved resulting in case closure.
- 12 courtesy notices of violation from previous months compliance were achieved resulting in closure.
- 219 cases courtesy notices of violation/notice of violation complied year to date.

BUILDING

Building permit activity increased 66.67% from April to May. The total number of building permits issued in April was 51 compared to 85 in May. Permit activity for May 2024 increased by 46.55% from May 2023.

Revenues for Building related fees for May were \$13041.00.
