WHEREAS, given the United States of America recently commemorated the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, it is now fitting and proper to recognize the two hundred and thirty-ninth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Arthur W. Bryant, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grosse Pointe Woods in the State of Michigan do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as **CONSTITUTION WEEK** and urge all citizens to study the Constitution and reflect on the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by ardently protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties.
