SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR 2022 CDBG ACTIVITES

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Wayne County have invited the community's to participate in the Request for Proposals for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2022 Activities Program. Each participating community will receive \$20,000 to be utilized on qualifying projects and/or public service.

Annually, each community has the option of designating the \$20,000 on qualifying projects and/or a public service of their choice.

Once again, it is the intent of the Village of Grosse Pointe Shores, Grosse Pointe Farms, Grosse Pointe City, Grosse Pointe Park and Harper Woods to allocate \$6,000 (30%) of the \$20,000 to PAATS and the remaining \$14,000 (70%) to *The Helm Life Center* for senior center operations.

It is my recommendation that City Council authorize the City Administrator to submit the city's 2022 CDBG Application allocating \$6,000 (30%) of the \$20,000 in CDBG public service funds to PAATS and the remaining \$14,000 (70%) to *The Helm Life Center* for senior center operations to Wayne County for inclusion in Wayne County's Annual Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development by the February, 2022 deadline.
