Subject: Chene-Trombley Park Update

On October 10, 2022, the Mayor, Council Member/Foundation liaison Granger, Administration, and the Director of Public Services met with members from Stucky Vitale Architects and Grosse Pointe Woods Foundation members Lisa Fuller and Peter Ahee to discuss the proposed tot-lot project for Chene-Trombley Park.

After discussion, the Foundation members requested additional funds to help complete the project. The additional costs are due to inflation, installation of security cameras, and rubber safety matting. Attached is a cost breakdown of the of the tot-lot project.

In the 2022/2023 Fiscal year, the city budgeted \$382,800 for the Chene-Trombley Park project. City council has approved a purchase order to Stucky Vitale for engineering fees in the amount \$16,500.00 for the project. The city committed \$320,000 towards the project with a commitment from the Foundation of \$60,000. Currently, the Foundation has raised \$70,000 and expects to continue to fundraise. However, in the event that they are unable to generate additional funding, they have requested the remaining uncommitted funds of \$46,300 from the city be applied towards the tot-lot project.

This request would still allow for the tot-lot project to remain within budget.
