CITY OF GUSTAVUS ORDINANCE FY25-12

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CITY ORDINANCE TITLE 2 ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 2.40 - CITY COUNCIL PROCEDURES, SECTION 2.40.140 - TELEPHONIC PARTICIPATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GUSTAVUS CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Gustavus Municipal Code.
- Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and its application to other persons, or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. Enactment. Now therefore, it is enacted by the Gustavus City Council that Title 2, Chapter 2.40.140 be amended as follows:

Bold and Underlined items are additions. Strikeout items are deletions.

TITLE 2 - ADMINISTRATION

Chapter 2.40 – CITY COUNCIL PROCEDURES

Section 2.40.140- Telephonic Virtual participation

- (a) Any member of the city council may participate via telephone <u>virtually</u> in a city council meeting, if the member declares that circumstances prevent physical attendance at the meeting.
- (b) No more than the first two (2) members to contact the clerk regarding telephonic <u>virtual</u> participation in a particular meeting may participate <u>via telephone</u> <u>virtually</u> at <u>any one</u> (1) meeting <u>unless otherwise declared by the Mayor</u>. No member may participate telephonically <u>virtually</u> at more than three (3) general meetings in any twelve-month period, October to October, <u>or at more than two consecutive general meetings</u>. There shall be no limit to the number of special or emergency meetings that a member may participate in telephonically <u>virtually</u>. A member may participate telephonically only from locations within the United States, unless the member agrees to pay the costs of international telephone service.
- (c) The member shall notify the clerk and presiding officer, if reasonably practicable, at least four (4) hours in advance of a meeting which the member proposes to attend by telephone virtually and shall provide the physical address of the location, the telephone number, and any available facsimile, email, or other document transmission service.
- (d) At the meeting, the clerk shall establish the telephone connection when the call to order is imminent.
- (e) A member participating by telephone **virtually** shall be counted as present for purposes of quorum, discussion, and voting.

- (f) The member participating by telephone <u>virtually</u> shall make every effort to participate in the entire meeting. From time to time during the meeting the chair shall confirm the connection.
- (g) The member participating by telephone **virtually** may ask to be recognized by the mayor to the same extent as any other member.
- (h) To the extent reasonably practicable, the clerk shall provide backup materials to members participating by telephone **virtually**.
- (i) If the telephone connection cannot be made or is made then lost, the meeting shall commence or continue as scheduled and the clerk shall attempt to establish or restore the connection, provided that if the member participating by telephone virtually is necessary to achieve a quorum, the meeting shall be at ease, recess, or adjourn as necessary until the telephone connection is established or restored.
- (j) Meeting times shall be expressed in Alaska time regardless of the time at the location of any member participating by telephone **virtually**.
- (k) Remarks by members participating by telephone <u>virtually</u> shall be transmitted so as to be audible by all members and the public in attendance at the meeting, provided that in executive session the remarks shall be audible only to those included in the executive session. To assure confidentiality, participants attending virtually will be excluded from executive sessions.
- (l) As used in this ordinance, "telephone" virtual means participation by telephone or any system for synchronous two way voice communication digital video-conferencing platform.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the Gustavus City Council.
