AGENDA ITEM TOPIC: New Sewage Pump for Chilson Commons Pump Station

Requested Action

- Approve the quote from Kennedy Industries to order and install a new 6 horsepower pump for the Chilson Commons pump station in the amount of \$12,796.00.

Background

The Chilson Commons pump station has two pumps; one 6 hp pump that does 80 gallons per minute and a smaller one that only pumps 20 gallons per minute. The soon to be constructed car wash will discharge into this pump station and their development team is concerned that if the larger pump were to go down for any length of time, it could negatively impact their operation. To address this concern, they have offered to pay for a new 6hp to be purchased and installed. We would then use the extra smaller pump as a spare in case anything happened to one of the larger pumps. The pump has a sixteen-week lead time so we would order it now, pay for the pump when it comes in, and then invoice the car wash for the total price of \$12,796.00.
