#### FIRE PREVENTION INFORMATION:

**Inspections:** As of December 31, 2024, the department had conducted commercial building inspections for all commercial establishments within the Township.

**Site Plan Reviews**: 2 plan reviews were completed during the month of December

#### **2024 PUBLIC SAFETY YEAR IN REVIEW HIGHLIGHTS:**

- The Hamburg Township Public Safety Drone Team received official notification that the team had earned *Unmanned Aircraft Systems* validation status from the Michigan Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS) on January 23, 2024.
- The HTFD Fire Command staff, in collaboration with Dr. Lew Bender, developed a First-line Supervisors Training Program that all of our first-line supervisors have attended, along with well-over 70 other supervisors from across the state. This program has grown into several new seminars, each expanding on the knowledge learned from the last seminar. It is continuing to grow with another seminar scheduled for May of 2025. This is the only training first-line training program of its kind for the fire service in Michigan.
- The department obtained Police Accreditation certification through the Michigan Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission on June 18, 2024.
- The department was authorized by the Township Board to add two new full-time police officer positions bringing the number of full-time police officer positions to 20. Officer Kelly Kozowicz was sworn in on October 1, 2024 and the second new officer is beginning the police academy in January of 2025.





- The department added six new full-time Fire Lieutenants who were selected, promoted and placed into service on November 4, 2024, resulting in both Fire stations being manned 24/7.
- For the second year in a row, the department obtained an annual commercial building fire inspection rate of 100%.
- Deputy Chief Zernick and Captain Yost each completed their Bachelor's Degrees this year and are now working on obtaining their Master's Degrees.
- Captain Lawver completed the Fire School of Staff and Command through Eastern Michigan University. He graduated in December after a 10-month program.
- Three of the four Captains successfully completed Fire Inspection training and are now certified Fire Inspectors, raising our number to four trained Fire Inspectors. Captain Vultaggio is currently working on his Fire Inspector certification and should be certified in 2025.
- During the 2024 calendar year, Community Risk Reduction firefighters conducted a total of 40 home inspections and installed 217 smoke detectors.
- The refurbished Tanker 12 was completed and returned to service.
- HTFD received a new Fire Rescue boat through the Firehouse Subs Grant program at no cost. It is housed at Station 12 and is valued at over \$20,000.
- Primary statistics show that the department once again had a Crime Clearance Rate in excess of 50% and 2024 marked the 12<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that Hamburg Township had a clearance rate well above the state average.
