AGENDA ITEM TOPIC: Speed Study Results for Cordley Lake Rd

Requested Action

Motion to receive and file the speed study report from the Livingston County Road Commission indicating that the 85th percentile speed was 44 mph at both study locations, confirming that the current posted speed limit of 45 mph is appropriate and that no further action is necessary.

Background

At the March 17, 2026, Board meeting, the Township Board adopted a resolution requesting that the Livingston County Road Commission conduct a speed study on Cordley Lake Road to determine whether the current posted speed limit of 45 mph should be lowered.

The Livingston County Road Commission conducted the study by placing traffic-counting equipment at two locations along Cordley Lake Road. The westerly unit was installed beneath a 45-mph speed limit sign approximately 0.45 miles east of Whitewood Road on a straight section of roadway. The easterly unit was installed beneath a 45-mph speed limit sign approximately 0.42 miles west of Kress Road between two horizontal curves.

The equipment remained in place for several days to collect traffic data. The results showed an 85th percentile speed of 44 mph at both locations. Based on these findings, the Livingston County Road Commission concluded that the existing posted speed limit of 45 mph is appropriate for this section of roadway.

Because the study supports the current speed limit, no further action is recommended at this time.
