- MDNR Manly Bennett Park & Water Trail Access Improvements #TF22-0107
 - Vendor for the the MDNR Plaque is no longer in business and the MDNR is in search of a new vendor. Once we have that information we will order the plaque. Per our Grant Coordinator, we won't be penalized if we don't have it in place for the ribbon cutting.
 - Sensory garden has dirt and we are working on the final touches. A plan was distributed to the Committee.
- MDNR Zukey Footbridge – TF25-0213
 - Dolan stated boring bids were in and the selection process will take place and agreement will be presented to the board.
 - IMEG is the Prime Professional on this project.

C. Park & Trail Special Projects (Non-grant)

- StoryWalk Project – Dolan reported that pathway improvements and gardens are in process.
- West Park Field Repairs – H3 – Pending repair (we could really use the extra field)
- Play Area Interactive Art – East Park Pavilion – Pending
- Boardwalk in WP/Disc Golf – Boardwalk is closed due to extensive damage. We don't anticipate it will be open this summer. Claims have been submitted to MMRMA, with the need to discuss a long-term plan at the Township Board level.

- **Building & Grounds Report** – **Hoepfner** stated they have been watering the new plants and trees 6-7 per week, and the sprinklers are running at the playground. They

have been cutting back the trail as time allows but it is slow progress. Residents aren't always heeding the signs which is dangerous for everyone. Trees have been removed in Halls Creek and a drone flyover has been discussed as part of an ongoing maintenance plan. We are allowed to move trees and debris without a permit, and this effort will become part of an annual maintenance budget. Contractor will be hired to do late fall repairs to the Boardwalk. The board agreed to the insurance claim and will discuss a future budget to do a proper upgrade. Duane gave an update on the striping robot.

Dolan stated he would like to get all the user groups at an evening meeting and talk about their needs as groups and perhaps they can co-purchase the robot.

Henneman stated the upcoming Master Plan process is a good time to do that.

E. ADA Compliance in Parklands/Trail/Township

Henneman asked if the transition was ever completed on the Zukey Bridge. Hoppner confirmed the rotten wood was replaced but transition was never upgraded. Henneman requested it be added to his list in order to bring it to ADA compliance.
