WHEREAS, the study, completed in the spring of 2021, revealed that at that time, the salaries for Hamburg's 3 executive elected positions (Supervisor, Clerk and Treasurer) were lower than the salaries for elected officials comparable communities and recommended that these salaries be increased by 10%; and	
<b>WHEREAS,</b> the U S Bureau of Labor Statistics compensation cost increase for state and local government work increased by 4.9% from April of 2022 to March of 2023since the completion of the salary survey; and	ers
<b>WHEREAS,</b> the Township Supervisor, since May of 2009 has not had an Administrative Assistant, thereby saving the township hundreds of thousands of dollars in wages and benefits in the ensuing thirteen years;	ıg
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Township Supervisor is available to the elected, staff and residents of the township evenings a weekends by cell phone, email and often by meeting in person with residents and staff after hours;	nd
<b>NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED</b> , that the Township of Hamburg hereby increases the salary of the Superviby 5%, to bring it more in line with the median. The increase will bring the Supervisors' annual salary from \$80,452.74 to \$84,475.38 effective with the pay period beginning July 1, 2023.	sor
