1. The wastewater treatment plant was out of compliance for one day in February for total inorganic nitrogen.

- 2. At EGLE's request, we sampled monitoring well #12 for PFAS and the results came back as non-detect. We still have not been able to obtain water samples for PFAS testing from any of the four homes near Buck Lake due to a lack of response from the homeowners.
- 3. We had a virtual meeting with EGLE on 2/6 to discuss the next steps regarding PFAS at our wastewater treatment plant. At the meeting, our wastewater treatment plant was officially listed as an MPART site for PFAS. Moving forward, EGLE wants to see some additional testing results before anything else is done.

Field Jobs for the Month: This month we have completed our normal monthly checks along with the monitoring well sampling. The staff have started working on the manhole project in the Gallagher Blvd area. Brighton Wastewater brought over their camera trailer to visually see what is going on with some piping on Industrial Road, we found a belly in the gravity line that extends roughly 40ft out from MH-7. This belly is causing most of the solids and debris to settle and create a partial clog. We found this issue 2 weeks after Metro Industries had jetted our lines. Midwest Power Systems started on

replacing the discharge piping for Ore Station, we are now having issues with one of our key bypass valves to complete this work. A new valve will be installed by Watertap to finish this project and ensure we have a complete bypass for any future emergencies.
