WHEREAS, the twice-a-year changing of clocks associated with switching to/from Daylight Savings Time is an anachronistic and inconvenient practice that is neither necessary nor useful to the majority of Americans; and

WHEREAS, a majority of health officials have opined that it would be healthier for our circadian rhythms to stay on Daylight Standard Time and not switch to Daylight Savings Time and back again; and

WHEREAS, a majority of Americans desire to standardize their clocks and not have to adjust them twice a year based on what are now outdated or localized practices; and

WHEREAS, Hamburg Township wishes to express its support for the standardization of the nation to Daylight Standard Time to both state and federal legislators in the hopes they will act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hamburg Township Board of Trustees formally requests its state and federal legislators to enact legislation to standardize our state and nation on Daylight Standard Time and cease the biannual clock adjustment that is currently imposed on us.
