We hosted 2 clean-ups this year. The Community Clean-Up took place a little earlier in April on the 11th and was held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Paper shredding was provided between 9AM and Noon, and we hired our company to provide that service. We had a few more volunteers and staff members this year than in years past, which was extremely helpful. The traffic was steady but never overwhelming, and the set-up entering into Disc Golf and exiting Soccer drives works well.

Putnam Township had their event the same day and also used Monroes, which did cause some delays for receiving items, but I believe for the most part the day went smoothly. A special thank you to the Park Rangers for taking tallies on the items that came in... so helpful for this report! I also would like to thank Monroe's Rubbish, Padnos, and ElectroCycle for taking such good care of us!

We held a 2nd event on April 24, 2026, after we were approached by Kensington Woods School looking for a project for their Community Service Day. We combined efforts with Putnam Township, and with the help of Duane, Brian Ignatowski, and the Park Rangers, we managed a clean-up from Kress Rd., to D-19. Items removed from the trail included: a car bumper, hot water tank, tires, and misc. debris. Garden beds were also cleaned up, and mulch was placed to get ready for spring!

- Suggest planning co-sponsored Trail Clean-Up with Putnam and Green Oak Townships
