8. New Business

A. Impact Melanoma – Proposal

Quote was presented to install sunscreen dispensers in the parklands and/or trailheads prompted from a discussion originating with prior Supervisor and a resident. Discussion took place regarding maintenance, potential vandalism or misuse, and monitoring. Coordinator was asked to provide the Committee with list of ingredients and to start with 2 dispensers to monitor use and resident comments. It was also discussed that future dispensers could be added to the adopt a feature program.

Motion by Dolan, supported by Miller, to approve the purchase and installation of 2 sunscreen dispenser units through IMPACT Melanoma with the intent that one would be installed near the Pickleball courts, and the other at the Merrill Rd. Trailhead or East Park with the purchase to be adjusted to not include the posts.
