Title: Resolution 2025-12, Support for FY 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Application with Outagamie and Calumet Counties, Harrison, Kaukauna, Appleton and Buchanan for CTH KK Corridor.

Recommended Action: Motion to approve Resolution 2025-12, support for the FY 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant application.

Background and Additional Information: Over the past two months, Outagamie and Calumet County staff, Harrison, Buchanan, Appleton and Kaukauna along with East Central Regional Planning Commission have been discussing a joint application to the DOT for grant funds to study the CTH KK corridor from St. John Street to STH 55.

In order to be successful in a national competition for the grant, individual contributions are necessary from each of the adjacent municipalities and to show better commitment to have six government entities working together. The fairest way to handle the contribution was by street frontage which was calculated by Calumet County. Both counties have ordinances that only allow them to pay for a portion of their studies and require other local matches from neighboring municipalities.

Given the extensiveness of this study, Village staff encourages the Village Board commit to the funding to study the corridor and determine future improvements to benefit all communities. The \$28,089 would come from the Capital Improvements Fund. Should the grant not be awarded until 2026, we would budget for this match, otherwise there is fund balance in the Capital Improvements Fund to cover the costs.

As the board knows, this corridor is vital to the Village for both future economic development opportunities and quality of life.

Budget Impacts: \$28,089- Capital Improvement Funds
