PRODUCTS – LANDSCAPING

PRAIRIE SEED

The Village will supply the prairie seed to the selected contractor. Table 1 (Mesic Prairie) and Table 2 (Wet-to-Wet Mesic Prairie) contain prairie seed mixtures for this project. Tables 1 and 2 are located in Appendix B. The prairie seed will be supplied (pre-mixed) by the Village to the selected contractor.

EXECUTION – LANDSCAPING

PRAIRIE SEED

Contractor shall notify the Engineer at least three business days before the scheduled date and time of the prairie mix seeding. Prairie seeds and cover crop shall be installed between September 28th and November 15th, 2026. The location of the prairie seeding area(s) are shown on the drawing(s).

SITE PREPARATION

Seed in accordance with the following paragraphs in the fall, between September 28th and November 15th, 2026, but before the ground is frozen.

Harrow, disk or drag the prairie area to a depth of ½-inch to 1-inch prior to prairie seeding. Sow prairie seed uniformly with a broadcast seeder. Calibrate the seeder properly for uniform distribution of seed. Distribute seed quantities and types evenly across the entire area.

Do not perform broadcast seeding when winds exceed 5-miles per hour or when the seed bed is not in proper condition. Do not seed on saturated or frozen topsoil.

Cover areas planted with prairie seed with erosion control blanket, Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Class I, Type B (straw), immediately after seeding the prairie seed mix. Do not extend the erosion control blanket onto the safety shelf of the pond.

Do not use fertilizer for the prairie seed planting.

Provide warranty that 75% (minimum) of the prairie grasses and forbs will be growing at the end of the second full growing season, with an average area density of at least, three plants/square foot of any seeded prairie grass or forb for every 2,000 square feet.

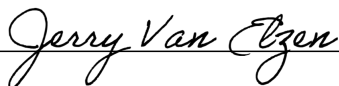

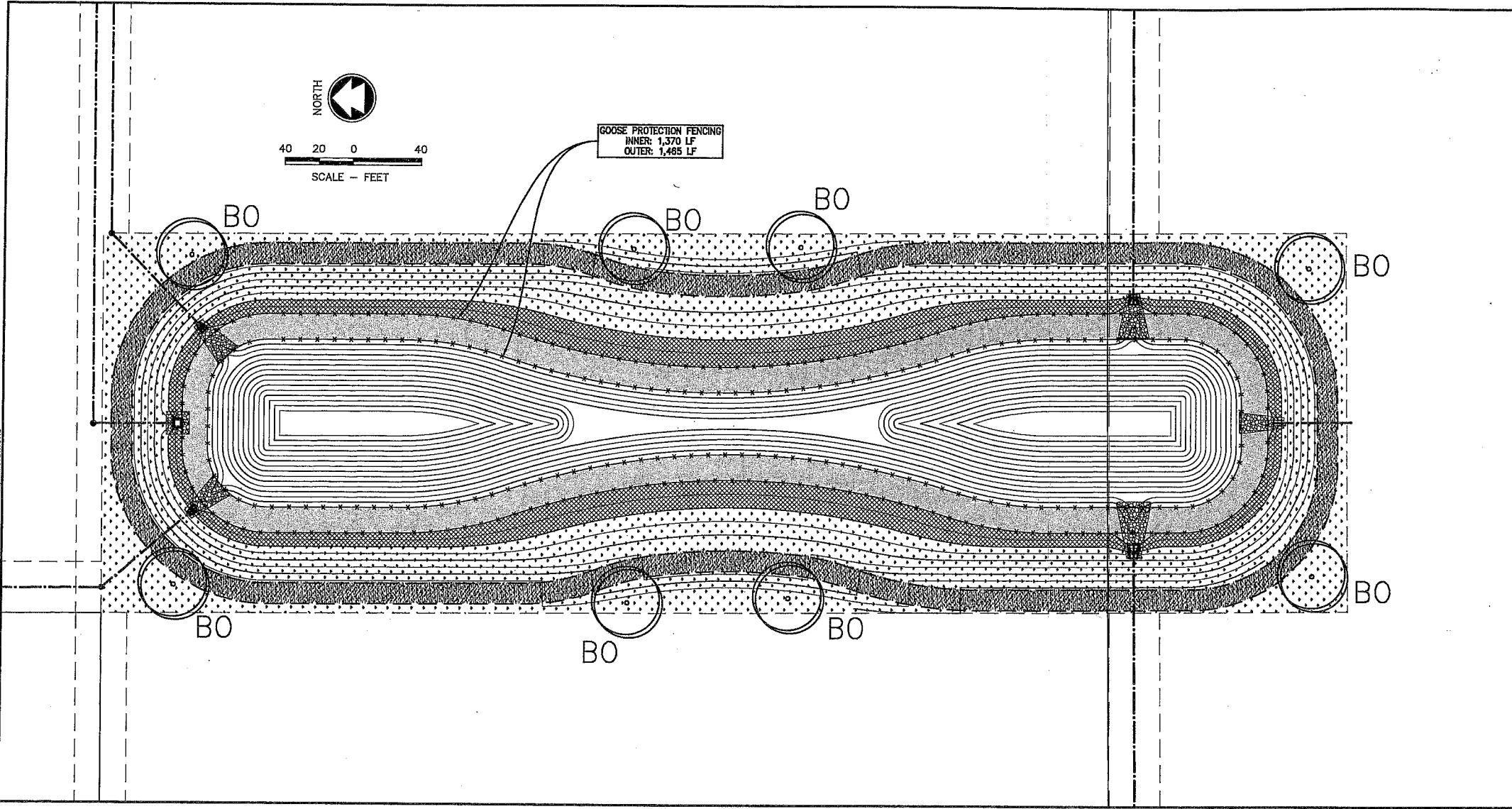

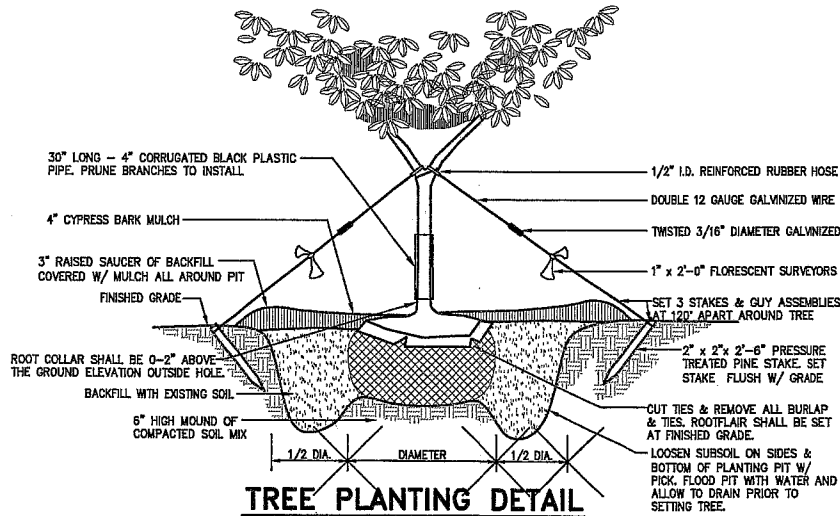

- TOPSOIL ON THE SAFETY SHELF SHALL BE DECONSOLIDATED TO A DEPTH OF 9" PRIOR TO THE POND FILLING WITH WATER.
- TOPSOIL ON THE PRAIRIE AREAS SHALL BE DECONSOLIDATED TO A DEPTH OF 4" PRIOR TO TEMPORARY SEEDING.
- THE WHITE & YELLOW LILIES SHOULD BE MIXED AND PLANTED EVERY 7 FEET ALONG THE INTERFACE OF THE SAFETY SHELF AND DROP-OFF OF THE PONDS. (NOT SHOWN ON PLAN)
- INSTALL ONE BLUE FLAG IRIS EVERY 5 FEET AROUND THE SHORE LINE EDGE OF THE PONDS. (NOT SHOWN ON PLAN)
- INSTALL ONE LAKE SEDGE EVERY 4 FEET AROUND THE SHORELINE EDGE OF THE PONDS (NOT SHOWN ON PLAN)
- INSTALL ONE WATER SEDGE EVERY 4 FEET AROUND THE SHORELINE EDGE OF THE PONDS (NOT SHOWN ON PLAN)
- THE FIRST ROW OF WETLAND PLANTS SHALL BE INSTALLED ONE FOOT FROM THE SHORELINE EDGE (THIS DOES NOT PERTAIN TO BLUE FLAG IRIS AND SEDGES). THE OUTER ROW OF WETLAND PLANTS SHALL BE INSTALLED ONE FOOT FROM THE DROP OFF INTO THE DEEP BASIN. THE IN-BETWEEN ROWS SHALL HAVE A SEPARATION DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 4 FEET.
- THE SOFTSTEM BULRUSH MUST BE 10" IN HEIGHT AND BURREED MUST BE >16" IN HEIGHT.
