Title: Open discussion and possible action to discuss future contract terms between the Village of Harrison and the Village of Sherwood/Town of Woodville related to a fire service contract and Fire Station 60 prior to potentially going into closed session to discuss strategy and bargaining authority for the Village Manager to use in negotiation of future of Fire Station 60.

Recommended Action:

Motion to proceed into Closed Session.

Background and Additional Information:

Village staff has shared the documents reviewed at the March 10, joint board meeting with Woodville and Sherwood clerks. No response was received from Woodville. Sherwood Village Clerk responded that the information was received. No further correspondence was received. The Village Manager reached out via email to the Interim Administrator in Sherwood and a response was received. No other information has been discussed with either Woodville or Sherwood.

The renovation of Fire Station 60 is included in the 2027 Capital Improvements Budget. After meeting with McMahon to finalize the floor plan and start a detailed design, an updated opinion of value was provided for renovation at approximately \$2.3 Million. The Village Manager requested McMahon provide a cost to build a new station of approximately 10,000 SF and the cost was provided at \$2,650,000. The board will need to discuss next steps in closed session related to land purchase and costs to do so.
