Title:

Special Event Permit for Brody Hietpas (Brodazoffa)

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends approving the Special Event Permit allowing July events to occur with the listed conditions.

Background and Additional Information:

Brody Hietpas has submitted a request for a Special Event Permit to allow outdoor sound amplification (amplified music) during a series of events planned for the summer of 2026. This request is part of a recurring monthly application process, where Mr. Hietpas intends to submit permits for each subsequent month's events in advance.

July 2026 Event Dates:

July 12, 2026 – Craft Flea and Art Fair

July 18, 2026 -- Private Event

The Calumet County Sheriff's Office has confirmed there have been no complaints or incidents reported at this address.

Harrison Fire Rescue has reviewed and approved the Emergency Action Plan submitted with the following conditions:

1. The tent must be fire rated and posted with "No Smoking" signs. Emergency access lanes must be maintained.
2. Any food truck will need to be inspected and be in compliance with fire code.
3. Food trucks should be no more than 200' from the road or emergency access to the property in case of a fire. No cooking should take place with 10' of a building or under tents. If using portable generators, they must be kept 10' from the truck or other combustibles and protected at all times.
