Background and Additional Information:

- 1. The Village has recruited one part-time seasonal employee for the fall to assist with lawn cutting and other maintenance related items. The Village is still in need of winter seasonal personnel to assist with snow plowing.
- 2. DPW staff removed the old salt shed for garage bay construction at Village Hall.
- 3. DPW staff installed a culvert pipe and gravel along Woodland Road at Coop Road for safe crossing of residents.
- 4. Staff installed two additional speed radar boards on Lake Park Road between Midway and Manitowoc Roads.
- 5. Parks staff has spread wood chips on the trails in Darboy Park forest after the removal of 348 dead ash trees.
- 6. Staff replaced the culvert on Manitowoc Road and Coop Roads to provide for better draining of stormwater in the Dan Stumpf property.
- 7. Staff assisted the Town of Woodville in shouldering their roads as contracted services.
- 8. Staff has been grading trails and park improvements at Rennwood Park. Staff is also maintaining the grassy areas of the park.
- 9. Staff is updating No Parking signs around the village.
- 10. Following up on a lot of ditch, culvert and drainage way issues.
