Title:

Yard Waste Stickers

Background and Additional Information:

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve integrated services for residents and customers, staff have been evaluating one of our highest foot-traffic services—the sale of annual yard waste stickers for access to the yard waste site.

Currently, residents frequently stop by in person to purchase these stickers. To increase efficiency and convenience for both residents and staff, we are proposing a shift from a one-year sticker to a two-year sticker.

Under this proposal, the sticker would display a two-year range (e.g., 2026–2027), and each subsequent year, a new two-year sticker would be issued (e.g., 2027–2028). This approach eliminates the need to prorate sticker costs when only one year remains.

The proposed cost of the two-year sticker would be \$40, equivalent to the cost of purchasing two one-year stickers. Our goal is to reduce the inconvenience of yearly renewals while maintaining affordability. A \$5 replacement fee would be applied to any lost or misplaced sticker.

Looking ahead, into the new year, the goal is to expand online services with our new credit card provider. The two-year sticker model would also help reduce postage and administrative costs associated with mailing stickers as we move toward online ordering.

Staff is looking to get feedback on the topic to plan for the budget process, and also update the fee schedule accordingly for 2026.
