- ☐ Reviewed existing server infrastructure, backups, storage capacity, and aging equipment and began developing plans for future server replacement and modernization.
- ☐ Continued improvements to Village network infrastructure, including troubleshooting switches, wireless access points, network connectivity, VLANs, and communications between Village facilities.
- ☐ Continued work on Village meeting and A/V systems, including improvements to recording, presentation, and remote video capabilities.
- ☐ Assisted with electronic open-records requests, including collection and processing of email records and other electronic information.
- ☐ Began development of the 2027 IT budget and longer-term technology replacement planning, including computers, servers, network equipment, wireless infrastructure, software licensing, and other technology needs.
