Title: Municipal Code Update: Chapter 16- Offenses

Recommended Action: Motion to approve repealing and recreating Chapter 16 of the Harrison Municipal Code, Offenses.

Background and Additional Information:

The Village issued two public comment periods for this ordinance chapter totaling approximately 60 days of public feedback.

The first public comment period for this Chapter, we received comments regarding the hunting requirements and in the second revision brought back all the language about hunting in the village including the wavier. The Village Manager heard from Don Mielke numerous times about several concerns and shared revised language with Don and he accepted it.

We also heard comments about loitering that were updated age changes as well for purchase of tobacco items and a request from the Village Attorney to add the quick reference code sections back in the beginning of the ordinance.

The second public comment period did not generate any comments.
