Title: Public Works/ Engineering/Parks/Trails Report

Issue: None

Background and Additional Information:

1. Staff has submitted \$63,000 for reimbursement for overtime costs through the WI Disaster Fund for the snow event on March 14-16.
2. DPW staff has spent time grinding brush at the yard waste site. Mulch and Wood Chips are available for residents to pick up.
3. DPW staff has been screen asphalt millings at the Yard Waste site to use on the trail around the Emerald Pond. Work on this project should begin next week once it dries out.
4. Staff has been following up on a lot of clogged culverts and storm sewers from the recent storms. No infrastructure damage has been reported from the storm in the Village.
5. Reclaiming the shoulders is underway.
6. Staff will be excavating for the installation of the new playground at Cameo Court and the new swings at Farmers Field to be installed the first two weeks of May.
7. Staff has chosen the colors of the siding, roofing and split face book at Farmers Field Pavilion. The school district estimates the metal roofing will be installed in the next two weeks.
8. Snowplows will be removed from the dump trucks in the coming weeks.
9. Pothole filling has been happening all over the village.
10. Village listed a used Ferris Zero Turn mower on the WI Surplus Auction. Final cost should be around \$7,000.
11. Grass cutting will start in the next week with part-time help.
12. Trail installation and dead ash tree removal is occurring in the Rennwood Forest.
13. April training for DPW staff include trench and excavation safety, aerial platform, PPE, chainsaw and bloodborne pathogens, slips, trips and falls.
14. Approximately 20+ new No Parking signs have been installed.
