This Notice of Intent Not to Renew (this “Notice”) relates to that certain Fire Protection Agreement entered into by and between the Village of Harrison (“Harrison”) and the Town of Woodville (“Woodville”) on January 9, 1985 and May 16, 1992 (hereinafter the “Fire Protection Agreement”).

**WHEREAS**, Harrison and Woodville entered into a Fire Protection Agreement on or about January 9, 1985.

**WHEREAS**, prior to said Fire Protection Agreement, Woodville did not maintain a fire department in the western half of the Town but desired to obtain fire protection for its residents.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute §60.55(1)(a)(3) a town may provide fire protection services within its town limits by multiple options including, “contracting with any person.”

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §990.01(26), a “person” under Wisconsin statutes includes all partnerships, associations, and bodies corporate and politic, which includes Harrison.

**WHEREAS**, Harrison determined that Woodville was not paying the full cost of services provided by Harrison to Woodville for said fire protection services.

**WHEREAS**, Harrison offered Woodville a new contract for consideration which would require Woodville to pay the full cost of fire protection services and hopes to enter into said proposed contract prior to the expiration of the existing Fire Protection Agreement;

**WHEREAS**, Harrison wishes to exercise its power to terminate the existing Fire Protection Agreement effective at 12:00 am on January 1, 2027.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Harrison does hereby notify Woodville of its intent to not renew the existing Fire Protection Agreement in 2027; accordingly, the current Fire Protection Agreement shall terminate at 12:00 am on January 1, 2027. Woodville is advised to arrange for its fire protection utilizing alternative methods provided for in the Wisconsin Statutes on and after 12:00 am on January 1, 2027 in the event Harrison and Woodville are unable to enter into a new Fire Protection Agreement prior to said expiration. This Notice was approved by the Village of Harrison Village Board on \_\_\_\_\_ at a duly-noticed meeting of the Village Board.
