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**Title:** GIS Equipment Purchase: Harrison Utilities and Stormwater Utility

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**Recommended Action:**

Motion to approve purchase of two Trimble GPS units for data collection for Harrison Utilities and the Stormwater Utility for \$13,531.70.

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**Background and Additional Information:**

Both Harrison Utilities and the Village Stormwater Utility are currently creating GIS systems to inventory and document all of their respective infrastructure. The Utility already owns one Trimble GIS unit and is looking to purchase another one for the GIS intern summer help that will be working with Utility staff to gather additional infrastructure data in neighborhoods that our files are incomplete. Staff feels it will be more cost effective for staff to obtain the data then hiring McMahon to collect the data such as curb stops, hydrants, valves, etc.

Staff in DPW will also use a unit to start documenting outfall locations, storm sewer catch basins and manholes and ponds as well as maintenance activities to be able to track progress to report to the DNR under new reporting requirements.

The units are unbudgeted items, but will be covered with non-general funds through the Water/Sewer Utility and the Stormwater Utility. This is first step in working to get village records digital versus paper and accessible in the field for staff.

\$6,765.85- Water/Sewer Utility split 50%, \$6,765.85- Stormwater Utility
