Title: Proposed Amendment to the Village of Harrison Parking Regulations

Issue: Does the Village Board support amending the parking regulations from no parking on village streets year-round to no parking only from November 1 to May 1 and keeping the same timeframe currently in ordinance from 3:00AM to 7:00AM.?

Background and Additional Information:

A future agenda item from Trustee Lancaster, seconded by Trustee Handschke to review the Village parking regulations was added at the February meeting.

Village staff reviewed surrounding communities and found the following information:

Community	Parking Reg
Sherwood	2:30-6:30 am 11/1-4/1
Menasha	2-6 am 11/1-3/31
	April -Oct odd/even basis parking
Hilbert	3-7am 11/15-4/15 except physicians on emergency calls
Brillion	1-6 am 11/15-4/1 no parking without prior permission from the police dept
Kaukauna	2-6 am 12/1-3/31
Grand Chute	2-6 am 11/1-4/1 no more than 30 minutes allowed except emergency response vehicles
Buchanan	2-6 am 11/1-3/31

Village staff met with the Fire Department, Public Works Department, and Calumet County Sheriff's Department to review the findings and generate the recommendation. At this time, the group suggests the following changes be considered by the board:

1. Modify ordinance to restrict parking on all village streets from November 1 (11/1) to May 1 (5/1). The rest of the year parking would be allowed.
2. Keep the current hours of 3:00 AM to 7:00 AM.

Village staff is looking for input from Trustees on the proposed ordinance change and then recommend the Board table this item until the April agenda to allow for resident input prior to adoption.
