## ORDINANCE V25-06

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, SECTION 6-3 KEEPING OF FOWLS.

**WHEREAS**, Village ordinance 6-3, Keeping of Fowls adopted in 2015, states the limit to the keeping of up to total of four chickens, doves, poultry or fowl per property and up to a 25 square foot enclosure.

**WHEREAS**, there is public interest in increasing the total number of fowls per property and amending the size of the enclosures, and

WHEREAS, a review of the surrounding communities' fowl ordinances were used as part of the recommendation to amend the ordinance, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, amending the size of the enclosure meets that standard based on the number of fowl and the square feet of space required for them.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** the Village Board of the Village of Harrison, Calumet County, State of Wisconsin, does hereby amend ordinance 6-3 as follows:

## Sec. 6-3. Keeping of Fowls.

(c) Chicken coops and yards, dove cotes, and other buildings or yards permitted under this section shall be limited to the keeping of up to a total of six four chickens, doves, poultry, or fowl per property, and shall be subject to the following conditions:

(5) No enclosure shall be located closer than 35 feet to any residential structure on an adjacent lot and shall not exceed **30** <del>25</del>-square feet **for an inside coop and no more than 60 square feet run** unless permitted as an accessory building.
