1. Emergency Response

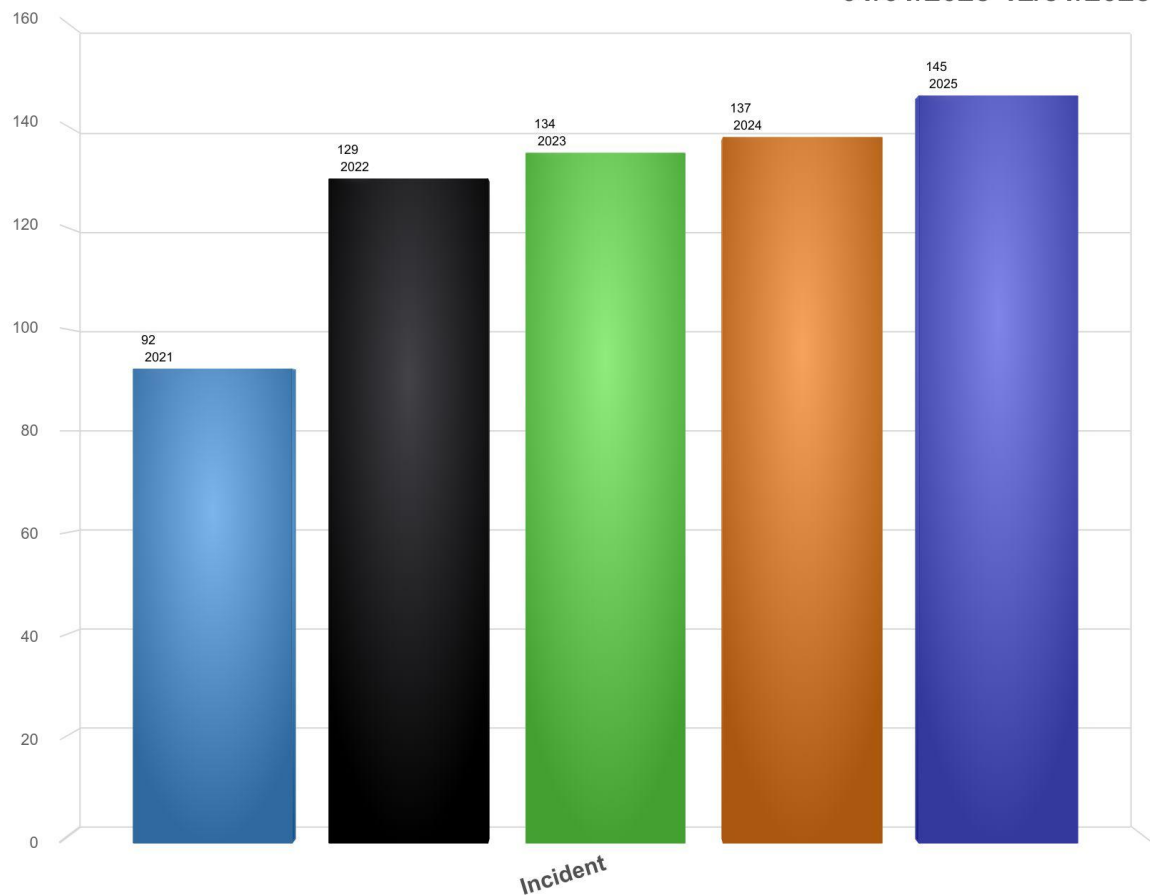
Harrison Fire Rescue was dispatched to 51 emergency incidents in February.
