Title: Proposal to install a key-fob security system at Harrison Utilities.

Issue: Does the Village Board approve installation of a key fob system at Harrison Utilities building for additional security related to his entering/existing the building?

Background and Additional Information:

Village staff obtained a bid from TECC to install a key fob system at Harrison Utilities building. The key fobs would be managed through the current Virtual keypad technology the Village Manager monitors.

Currently the building is master keyed, however there is no way of monitoring who is entering/existing the building. Also, we do not have to manage who has keys to the facility.

TECC is the current vendor that does all security at Village facilities, therefore only one proposal was obtained for this project.

Budget Impacts: \$12,277.73 from Misc General Expense Fund Balance of Water/Sewer Enterprise Funds.

Recommended Action: Motion to approve the proposal from TECC for \$12,277.73 at Harrison Utilities building.
