Subject: Judicial Security Act - Confidentiality Agreement

Dear Clerk -

On April 1, 2025, Act 235, the Judicial Privacy Act, went into effect. The basis of the law is to provide current and former judicial officers with statutory protection of their personal information and the personal information of their immediate family residing in their home. A requirement of the law is that every government agency is required to have signed confidentiality agreements with all 3rd parties who may have access to or receive such information. Attached is the Confidentiality Agreement Outagamie County created to meet this requirement. Please review the agreement, including with your counsel, if desired, sign, and return the agreement to me within the next two weeks. If you or your counsel have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out.
