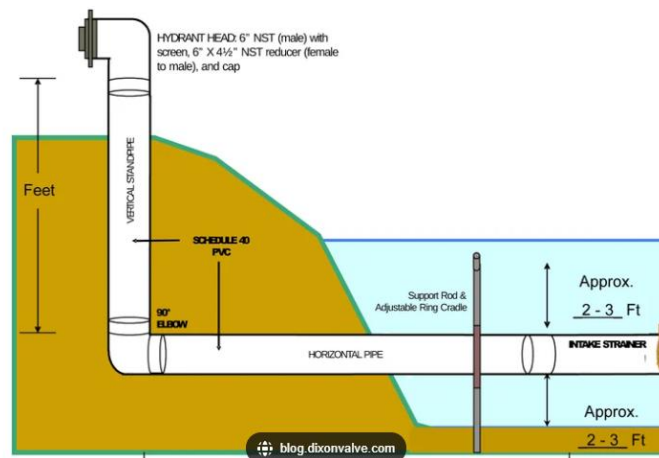
Title: Change Order: Installation of Dry Hydrant at Fire Station 70 Site/Stormwater Pond

Recommended Action: Motion to approve Change Order No. 1 to Donald Hietpas and Sons for \$14,500 for dry hydrant installation.

Background and Additional Information:

The Fire Department has requested the installation of dry hydrant into the village owned stormwater pond north of the new fire station for training purposes. The hydrant needs to be installed prior to the pond filling up water.

What is a dry hydrant? A dry hydrant is a permanently installed, unpressurized pipe that allows firefighters to access water from a nearby source, such as a lake or pond.



Budget Impacts: Payment would come either from 2% dues (waiting for pre-approval from the State) or 2025 contingency funds and account number 100-06-52200-400-000, supplies
