Background and Additional Information:

Village staff continue to work on a number of major projects as detailed below:

- 1. Station 60 Renovation. McMahon continues to work on design of the station. Upcoming meetings are being planned to review the current layouts with stakeholders and the Board (in March)
- 2. New Station 70: Five Bugles continues to work with firefighters and staff on the specific design. Goal is bid the project in April/May
- 3. DPW Garage Expansion- McMahon continues to finalize drawing in preparation for bidding. The goal is bid the project in April.
- 4. The Municipal Generator Project at Village Hall is out to bid. Bids will be awarded at the March meeting
- 5. Utility Extension/ master site grading/detention pond construction at Harrison Commerce Park is out to bid and will be awarded at the March meeting.
- 6. Haen Heights and Cedar Ridge Estates re-ditching, culvert replacement and street resurfacing is being finalized, and Board will award bids at the March Meeting. This will also include Strawflower and Snapdragon resurfacing and a new parking lot at Rennwood Park
- 7. The Village's third squad car has been delivered and will be put on the road in the next month.
- 8. Village staff is working with Calumet County to update the lettering on the current squad to the new Harrison Patrol lettering.
- 9. The Village is selling a Public Works vehicle on WI surplus auction. Staff felt this was more fair way to dispose of the Village property.
- 10. Staff continues to work with Russ on updating the municipal codes. One meeting has been held to discuss the approach and the next steps.
