A RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HARRISON, WISCONSIN, REQUESTING THE VARIOUS LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL AGENCIES TO SUPPORT, FUND AND IMPLEMENT IMPROVEMENTS ON CTH KK WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HARRISON AND AREAS TO THE EAST AND WEST OF VILLAGE BOUNDARIES TO SOLVE THE TRAFFIC CONGESTION THUS IMPROVING THE SAFETY OF MOTORISTS, PEDESTRIANS, AND BICYCLISTS.

WHEREAS, CTH KK has become a major thoroughfare between the City of Appleton, the Town of Buchanan, City of Menasha, Village of Harrison and the City of Kaukauna; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Harrison is calling upon the following agencies to prioritize the upgrades to the CTH KK to accommodate the growing congestion to better serve the residents of the municipalities and to minimize continued traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, the following agencies are requested to work together to solve the traffic congestion issues:

- State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation
- Village of Harrison
- Town of Buchanan
- City of Appleton
- Outagamie County
- Calumet County
- State Elected Official representing this area
- Federal Elected Officials representing this area
- East Central Regional Planning Commission

WHEREAS, local residents continue to express concerns regarding the congestion on CTH KK between 441 and STH 55 and the safety of motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD, VILLAGE OF HARRISON, WISCONSIN AS FOLLOWS, that consideration of turn lanes and improvements to the business entrances be studied as part of the design and construction process

to implement immediate intermediate measures. Furthermore, design and implement other long-term improvements to develop a major throughfare that can handle the increased traffic demands long into the future.
