SECTION 106 CONSULTANT AGREEMENT – WRI WEST MAIN STREET PROJECT

At a Special meeting of the City of Hartford Commission, located at 19 West Main Street and called to order by Mayor Richard A. Hall on September 8, 2025

The following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS, the City submitted a Letter of Intent for a Water-Related Infrastructure Grant of \$2,491,110 from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) and the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF); and

WHEREAS, the MEDC has invited the City to continue with the application process for \$2,491,110 in grant funding toward infrastructure improvements on W. Main Street. The City committed \$307,890 in matching funds toward the \$2.799M project; and

WHEREAS, federal funds are involved, requiring the City to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for an section 106 consultant service. The RFP was distributed to pre-qualified consultants via email on August 12, 2025, and proposals were due August 29, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City received four proposals by the due date. Orbis Environmental Consulting at a cost of \$2,150; Environmental Stantec at a cost of \$4,150-\$9,251; Past Perfect at a cost of \$3,500; Chronicle Heritage at a cost of \$4,000; and

WHEREAS, Wightman's scored the proposals in accordance with the criteria established in the RFP, and all consultants submitted a favorable proposal. Staff recommends the lowest bidder, Orbis Environmental at a cost of \$2,150. The MEDC will reimburse the City for 100% of the costs of these services; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Commission approves the award to Orbis Environmental as the Section 106 Consultant at a cost of \$2,150 for the WRI West Main Street Project and authorizes the city manager to execute the Section 106 Consultant agreement.
