



RESOLUTION TO APPROVE WWTP TASK AGREEMENT

At a Regular Business meeting of the City of Hartford Commission, located at 19 West Main Street and called to order by Mayor Jane M. Danger on June 18, 2026 at 6:00p.m.

The following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS, Certified Operating Services identified that the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) is experiencing issues related to mercury levels, as well as other operational and infrastructure challenges; and

WHEREAS, Jones and Henry Engineers, Ltd. (J&H) presented the following tasks to address the mercury concerns and operational challenges at the WWTP; and

WHEREAS, Task 2 consists of J&H working closely with City of Hartford staff to evaluate key operational and infrastructure challenges at the WWTP and develop practical, cost-effective recommendations to improve reliability, safety, and long-term performance. The project will begin with a kickoff meeting and a review of available plant records, operational data, previous studies, and capital planning documents; and

WHEREAS, a site visit will be conducted to assess existing treatment processes, equipment, structures, electrical systems, and controls, with particular focus on the UV disinfection system, equalization (EQ) tank, and solids management facilities. The cost for Task 2 is \$34,500; and

WHEREAS, Task 3 consists of J&H working with Certified Operating Services to develop and manage a mercury sampling study to identify areas within the collection system that may be contributing to elevated mercury concentrations; and

WHEREAS, the study will utilize strategically selected sampling locations throughout the collection system to evaluate mercury levels and assist the City in narrowing down potential sources for future investigation and corrective action. The cost for Task 3 is \$13,500; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for Tasks 2 and 3 is \$48,000; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hartford City Commission hereby approves the agreement with Jones and Henry Engineers, Ltd. for Tasks 2 and 3 related to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant in the amount of \$48,000 and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement.
