



RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS FOR CITY HALL

At a Regular Business meeting of the City of Hartford Commission, located at 19 West Main Street and called to order by Mayor Jane M. Danger on June 18, 2026 at 6:00p.m.

The following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS, Christmas Décor by Naylor Landscape Management has submitted proposals to provide holiday decorations for City Hall for the 2026 Christmas Season; and

WHEREAS, the company has successfully provided holiday decorations for both City Hall and Ely Park for several consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, the proposed decorations include the two pine trees surrounding the City Hall windows, the landscaping bushes along the side of City Hall, and the front and rear entrances; and

WHEREAS, upon approval of this resolution, the City intends to coordinate installation with Naylor Landscape Management in advance of the Red Arrow Convoy Lighted Truck Parade and Christmas in Hartford, an event sponsored by the Hartford Chamber of Commerce and Hartford Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive a fifteen percent (15%) discount if the required deposit is paid on or before June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) has budgeted funds for holiday decorations in Ely Park; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Naylor Landscape Management reflects the City's customary level of holiday decorations, and the City Manager will negotiate the final scope and pricing to remain within the approved budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the installation of holiday decorations at City Hall enhances the community's seasonal celebrations and contributes to the overall appearance of the downtown area; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hartford City Commission hereby approves an expenditure not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) for holiday decorations at City Hall to be provided by Christmas Décor by Naylor Landscape Management, consistent with the approved budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to finalize the scope of work, negotiate pricing within the approved budget, and execute any documents.
