



RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DWSRF 7777-01 CONTRACT D CHANGE ORDER 1

At a Regular Business meeting of the City of Hartford Commission, located at 19 West Main Street and called to order by Mayor Jane M. Danger on June 18, 2026 at 6:00p.m.

The following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS, Wightman's has presented Change Order No. 1 for Contract D of the DWSRF 7777-01 Hartford Water System Improvements Project to address modifications necessary to improve operations and ensure compliance with requirements of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) at the City's Iron Removal Plant (IRP); and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 includes modifications to chemical feed systems, replacement of chemical pump types, and other minor improvements to the chemical treatment systems at the IRP; and

WHEREAS, these improvements were identified and discussed with the Water System Operator during the preconstruction meeting and subsequent walkthrough of the IRP; and

WHEREAS, the current Water System Operator was not involved in the original design and planning of the project and has identified operational improvements that will enhance reliability, treatment performance, regulatory compliance, operational efficiency, and system consistency at the IRP; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 includes the following improvements:

- Installation of automatic valves integrated with the programmable logic controller (PLC);
- Replacement of fluoride and phosphate chemical feed pumps with peristaltic pumps;
- Increase in the size of the phosphate storage tank and associated scale equipment;
- Flow-paced control of the fluoride and phosphate chemical feed systems; and
- Installation of an automatic switchover system for Well No. 5 and finished water operations; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of Change Order No. 1 is Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$70,333.00); and

WHEREAS, sufficient project contingency funds are available to cover the cost of the change order; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change order has been reviewed and approved by the State of Michigan as part of the DWSRF-funded project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hartford City Commission hereby approves Change Order No. 1 for Contract D – Iron Removal Plant Improvements under the DWSRF 7777-01 Hartford Water System Improvements Project in the amount of Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$70,333.00); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 and any related documents.
