RESOLUTION 24-211

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FOR CYBERSECURITY RESOURCES FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) is a federal grant program funded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) that aims to improve cybersecurity in state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, in New Jersey, the SLCGP is administered by the NJ Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (NJOHSP), wherein the overall goal of the SLCGP is to make state and local government organizations more resilient to cyber threats; and

WHEREAS, for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2024, SLCGP funds received by NJOHSP to administer the grant will be used to provide hardware, software, and services to state and local government agencies; and

WHEREAS, all New Jersey state and local government entities are eligible to apply for NJ FFY 2024 SLCGP resources; and

WHEREAS, local government entities applying for such resources must also complete and submit the NJ SLCGP Local Consent Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands that the Mayor, Borough Administrator and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to submit an application for the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program for Cybersecurity Resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands that the Mayor, Borough Administrator and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to submit the NJ SLCGP Local Consent Agreement that is required as part of the aforesaid grant application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands that the Mayor, Borough Administrator and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all application(s), documents and/or agreement(s) for the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program for Cybersecurity Resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Borough Administrator and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to undertake such acts as are reasonable and necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.
