SUPPORTING THE ASSOCIATION OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY OPERATION REACH OUT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Operation Reach Out seeks to partner with local government, businesses, civic groups, and others to host networking opportunities and connect military families with support systems and available resources within their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Highlands recognizes the sacrifices made by members of the United States Armed Forces and their families and desires to support the initiatives that strengthen and assist military-connected residents within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds it fitting and appropriate to endorse the mission and goals of AUSN and Operation Reach Out in prompting outreach, education, and support for military members and their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Highlands as follows:

1. The Borough of Highlands hereby supports and endorses the mission and objectives of the Association of the United States Navy and its Operation Reach Out program.
2. The Borough Council encourages residents, businesses, and civic organizations to participate in and support initiatives that assist military personnel, veterans, and their families.
3. The Borough Council further authorizes Borough officials to coordinate with AUSN representatives regarding community outreach efforts and related programs intended to benefit military-connected families within the Borough.
