



RESOLUTION NO. 2024-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL REFERENDUM ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 11, 2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 2025, the Election Clerks and Inspectors subscribed their oaths and performed their duties in said Referendum Election in accordance with the law; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Canvassing Board members have certified the results of the Municipal Election as follows:

APPROXIMATE TOTAL REGISTERED VOTERS: 3,697

APPROXIMATE TOTAL RECORDED BALLOTS CAST: 391

BALLOT QUESTION 1 received 157 “NO” votes and 234 received “YES” votes:

Shall the Town be authorized to expend up to \$3,500,000 using budgeted funds for two public safety projects to improve operations, increase efficiency, preserve critical public safety infrastructure and enhance response services, including: (1) rehabilitation of the old fire station/apparatus bays and (2) construction of a public safety marine facility for marine unit docking and water rescue services?

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County Canvassing Board members have duly canvassed the returns of the described election and have certified the foregoing as true and correct tabulations of the total recorded and absentee votes cast; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission wishes to formally adopt and declare the voting results of the Municipal Referendum Election; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents and citizens of the Town of Highland Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Town Commission accepts the official results of the Municipal Referendum Election held on March 11, 2025 (**attached as Exhibit A**).

Section 3. The official results shall be entered and recorded in the minutes of the Town Commission.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
