SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2025-010

A Resolution of the Town Commission of the Town of Highland Beach, Florida, for assistance 2025 under the Florida Inland Navigation District – Waterways Assistance Program and providing for an effective date.

SUMMARY:

Consideration to approve Resolution No. 2025-010 of the Town Commission of the Town of Highland Beach Florida, for assistance 2025 under the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND)— Waterways Assistance Program.

The Marine Unit of the Highland Beach Police Department was started in 2022 after a series of waterway accidents. Since that time, the patrol boat has been housed at a slip owned by Boca Highlands Condominium. To establish a Town-owned police/fire dock, we intend to make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District – Waterway Assistance Program, for a 50% matching grant to fund Phase Two of the project. The proposed dock will be installed behind the Town Library and will serve public safety needs to include Police and Fire/ Rescue. Phase Two of the project is the construction cost. The total estimated cost of Phase Two is \$2,148,504,75.

\$1,074,252.37 (50% Matching Grant from FIND)
