SUBJECT: Execute Agreement via Piggyback
Shared Use Path Milling and Paving

SUMMARY:

On 6/29/2026, the Town received a \$375,000 State appropriation for the Pedestrian Safety Traffic Improvement Project, which consists of milling, repaving, and regrading the shared use path and installing in-ground lighting at all SR-A1A crosswalks. For the milling and repaving scope of the project, staff received a proposal from PaveConnect, who was sourced through OMNIA Partners contract #R220902, for \$263,260.80.

The contract was approved at the 7/14/26 Town Commission meeting. Some contract language has been modified at the request of the contractor. The Town Attorney has revised the contract to reflect the following changes: (1) Reducing the cost of liquidated damages to \$250.00 per day, (2) Capping liquidated damages at 10% of the Contract Price, (3) and extending the cure period from five days to ten days.

These changes will not have any fiscal impact on the project cost or budgeted funds.
