Agenda Items:

- 1. Tree Trimming on FPL Street Light and Electric Poles, suggesting a policy for public safety and sense of allowing the street lights to illuminate the street instead of tree tops. Also to identify invasive trees and plantings on the right of way in advance of sewer line repairs and problems with the trees' invasive root systems into sewers. This is suggesting Commission policy setting and will necessitate town oversight and follow up with utilities and its own maintenance staff. This policy should be enacted going forward. Further identification of invasive trees and shrubs on private property may be discussed. Photos of streetlights at day night forthcoming.
- 2. Water Report Followup: pertaining to the discussions by our water consultant last month, consideration of our reciprocal water agreements with Boca Raton and Delray Beach, with the latter expiring within a year. Discussion suggested about (a) exactly how many times we have transferred our water to Boca Raton and Delray Beach, and how many times they have transferred water to Highland Beach, with Delray; (b) resident water meters life span was reported at 5-10 years, thus establish a town policy to replace residents' meters at the end of their lifespans to ensure accurate readings.
- 3. Lobbyist in Tallahassee at the suggestion of elected state officials during covid restrictions. More data forthcoming.
