SUBJECT: Axon LPR Camera Contract Agreement

SUMMARY:

License Plate Recognition camera systems are utilized to support the safety and security efforts for the Town. Our current LPR cameras are the Flock system, which was approved a \$127,300 five-year contract agreement in 2023.

As a result of service and operational concerns, the Flock contract agreement is being canceled and replaced with Axon LPR camera systems to support the safety and security efforts of the Town. Axon is currently the provider for the police department's body worn cameras, in-car video cameras, evidence and drone software and FUSES, which is the system that integrates and consolidates all of our technology and allows us to share and receive information and intelligence.

The budgeted annual Flock contract payment (with live cameras) of \$28,900 will be replaced with the annual Axon contract payment of \$27,400.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This is a 5-year contract agreement with AXON for a total cost of \$109,500, to be paid out over the 5-year period at \$27,400.00 a year.

The Agreement was reviewed by the Town Attorney's Office for legal sufficiency.
