Case No. CC2022-04-001 (Monterey House Condominium): - Item 9A

MOTION: Lasorsa/Murray - Moved that Respondent(s) be found in violation of the Town Code as alleged in the Notice of Violation and that they be ordered to comply within 30 days or be fined \$ 250.00 per day for each day the violation remains after the date set for compliance and assess prosecution costs in the amount of \$250.00 payable by the date set for compliance. Upon roll call: Members Lasorsa (Yes), Murray (Yes), Axelrod (Yes), Vice-Chairperson Perlow (Yes), and Chairperson Schlam (Abstain). The motion passed.

Case No. CC2022-04-005 (Donald and Mary Krieff): - Item 9B

MOTION: Axelrod/Perlow - Moved that Respondent be found in violation of the Town Code as alleged in the Notice of Violation and that he be ordered to comply within 30 days or there will be a fine that will be commencing at \$250.00 per day which will remain per day fine until such time that it is full compliance, and there is an assessment of prosecution costs in the amount of \$.250.00 payable by the date set for compliance. In reference to the outstanding amount based upon the date set for original compliance that it should be essentially mitigated down to a \$1000.00 flat fee but in the event, it is not in compliance within the
