



## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-019

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2025-018 SETTING THE PROPOSED NOT TO EXCEED MILLAGE RATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065(2)(B), FLORIDA STATUTES, AND SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE AT WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND TENTATIVE BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, commonly known as the “Truth in Millage” Bill or the “TRIM” Bill, provides that each taxing authority shall advise the Property Appraiser of its proposed millage rate, of its current rolled back rate, and of the date, time, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and tentative budget;

**WHEREAS**, on July 15, 2025, the Town Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-18, setting the proposed not to exceed millage rate and the time and date for the first budget hearing; however, the Resolution contained the incorrect date for the Town’s first budget hearing, and the Town Commission wishes to amend Resolution No. 2025-018 to reflect the correct date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution.

**Section 2.** The proposed not to exceed tax millage rate of the Town of Highland Beach for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be:

**Section 3.** The Operating Millage roll-back rate for Fiscal Year 2024 is 3.1491 mills. As defined in Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the “rolled-back rate” is that certain millage rate which, exclusive of: new construction, additions to structures, deletions, increases in the value of improvements that have undergone a substantial rehabilitation which increased the assessed value of such improvements by at least 100 percent, property added due to geographic boundary changes, total taxable value of tangible personal property within the

jurisdiction in excess of 115 percent of the previous year's total taxable value, and any dedicated incremental value, will provide the same ad valorem revenue as was levied during the prior year less the amount, if any, paid or applied as a consequence of obligation measured by the dedicated incremental value.

**Section 4.** That the date, time, and place of the public hearing to consider the above proposed not to exceed millage rate and tentative budget shall be as follows:

**Section 5.** All resolutions or parts of resolution in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall be effective retroactive to July 15, 2025.
