Dear Mayors,

As you may know, the Recreation, Arts, and Parks tax will be on the November ballot. The County and municipalities currently have an agreement regarding the distribution of RAP tax revenue in Washington County, but that agreement is set to expire next year. The second amendment would extend the term of the existing revenue distribution agreement to 2035 (which would cover the life of the renewed RAP tax if it passes), and it would allow the County to collect an administrative fee from the RAP tax revenue to cover the costs associated with administering the RAP tax. Please review and sign the attached amendment and return to the Commission Office.
