Summary:

The town board asked staff to review the Community Re-Investment program. A draft policy has been included as a means to starting the conversation and obtaining board feedback on what the program will look like going forward.

A summary of initiatives, services, and programs funded by the town over the last five years has been included below. Some of these were funded via Community Re-Investment funds, while others were funded outside of that process. Ideally, the new policy would roll all outside agency funding into one process to ensure transparency and fairness in the funding process. Tourism Board and Tourism Development Authority allocations have also been included as a reference as to which agencies and programs have been funded via those programs. Note that these are budgeted amounts and may not reflect actual amount paid out.

In addition, as we review the existing program, it may also be a good time to evaluate how we're funding various agencies/programs, to ensure we're following best practices. For example, the School of Government has recommended that local governments not pay dues to civic or community organizations such as chambers, because it can be difficult to ensure that the funds are expended for purposes that local governments can directly fund. Instead, they suggest entering into a contract with the organization to fund a specific project, service or activity. The town is currently paying annual dues to the Hillsborough and Chapel Hill Chambers, which have been included in the chart as a reference.

Direction from the town board would be helpful for those items listed in the section near the end of this abstract titled: "Key Eligibility/Funding Considerations."

Key Eligibility/Funding Considerations

- Location/service area of agency
- Funding allocation method (i.e. penny on tax rate, % of General Fund budget, per capita, etc.)
 - Example Funding Policies
 - Apex policy of \$1/capita
 - Carrboro policy of 2.0% of general fund budget
 - Guildford County policy of 0.2% of general fund budget
 - High Point policy of one-third of a cent on tax rate
 - Other Examples (Couldn't find formal policies, so calculated % of general fund budget, per capita and tax rate equivalent as an FYI. Note that due to limited information, these may not be apples to apples in terms of funding sources and/or types of agencies/services/programs funded)
 - Brevard 0.62% of GF budget / \$10.37 per capita / 0.61 cents on tax rate
 - Chapel Hill 0.72% of GF budget / \$10.39 per capita / 0.66 cents on tax rate
 - Davidson 0.23% of GF budget / \$3.27 per capita / 0.11 cents on tax rate
 - Mebane 0.54% of GF budget / \$8.81 per capita / 0.39 cents on tax rate
- Follow UNC SOG guidelines and not pay dues to civic or community organization, such as a chamber of commerce, but rather enter into contracts for service?
- Funding priorities does the board want to establish priorities/focus areas?
- Funding decision process rubric, guiding questions, framework?
- Other?
