Dear Matt,

Temperatures are dropping into the 50s already with no further work having been done on Corbinton Commons' streets, alleys, and sidewalks. We are guessing that the asphalt-pouring season is over and hence the town will not take ownership of our infrastructure this year.

Last year our board worked with Margaret Hauth to arrange for the town to plow our streets and alleys for snow by executing a "hold harmless" agreement (see attached). The agreement we signed expired in April 2023. Would you be willing to provide us with a new agreement for the winter of 2023/24?

In December of 2022 we went before the Board of Commissioners to request this service, and they authorized it without any time limitations (see attached minutes). It's possible the town drafted the hold harmless agreement for a limited time because they hoped — as did we all — that the roads and alleys would be completed this summer.

If you would prefer that we go before the Board of Commissioners again, we can do so.
